BRING WITH YOU CHECKLIST

License, valid for species and area you are hunting

Conservation Stamp

Rifle

Ammunition

- Bow and at least one dozen arrows
- Camo clothing
- Camo makeup
- Cover-up scent
- Archery License

Nylon duffle bag for gear no longer than 26" (zipper style)

Flashlight w/ batteries

Sunglasses

Lip Balm / sunscreen / toiletries

Sleeping bag

Hunting knife

Bear mace (optional)

Compass

Camera

Binoculars

Matches in waterproof container

Small back Pack

Travel alarm

Water bottle

Medicine: aspirin, antacid, anti-diarrhea, prescriptions

Fishing rod in case no longer than 40 inches

Fishing license, buy before you come

CLOTHING

Rain gear, Coats & Pants (no ponchos they scare the horses)

Light to medium jacket

Good pair of waterproof boots/snow packs for late season hunters

Warm gloves / cap or hat
